

# PEACE LUTHERAN CHURCH GUIDELINES FOR RE-OPENING OCTOBER 4, 2020 10:00 AM

- If you are receiving this information by email, you may make a reservation by clicking the link at the bottom of this page. If this information is reaching you by the USPS, you may make a reservation on our Website at [www.peaceaz.org](http://www.peaceaz.org). look for our “Welcome Back” article. You may also contact the church office by noon on the Friday prior to our service. We would be glad to make the reservation for you. **(a reservation is required.)**
- Arrive on campus for check-in during the 15 minutes prior to the service;
- Please leave one space between your vehicle and others in the parking lot;
- Upon leaving your vehicle we ask you to wear a face mask;
- At the registration desk, your temperature will be checked as you are asked if you are healthy;
- This will be followed by giving you a ‘registration sticker’ and a pre-packaged communion kit;
- As you leave the registration table please cleanse your hands with the sanitizer provided;
- You will be met at the door by an usher who will open doors for registered guests, and other ushers will escort you to your pew (we will have sections for senior saints as well as for families with children);
- We will seat people from front to back and people will be dismissed from back to front;
- In the sanctuary we will maintain social distance between parties, there will be no singing (you can hum along) and we will commune in our pews. No printed materials will be distributed (you can print materials at home). If you have an offering, there are boxes on the back walls of the sanctuary;
- When dismissed there will be a trash receptacle outside to discard worship materials;
- There will be no coffee service (we encourage you to bring water). The area near the Memorial Garden is set aside for socializing (continue to wear masks and be sensitive to personal space);
- There will be no childcare provided, although the Cry Room will be available;
- If you need to utilize the restrooms, we ask for usage to be limited to one person at a time;
- Greeters and ushers will wear masks, while worship leaders in the chancel will wear face shields;
- We will notify all if there is someone in worship who tests positive for Covid-19.
